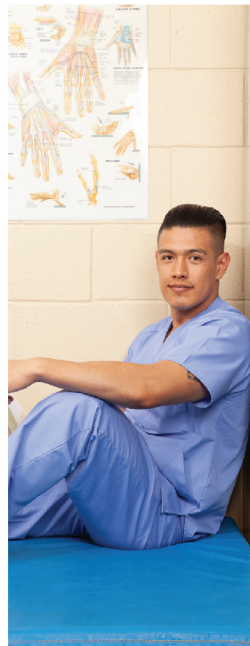

2023-2024 SCHOLARSHIP HONOREE OF THE YEAR OPERATION HELPING HANDS & KIM VALENTINE

Where will I sleep tonight? This question has been pondered by anyone forced into homelessness, and the profound impact it leaves is unforgettable.

At the age of 14, Kim Valentine found herself grappling with this very question. Although her own circumstances greatly improved over time, she never lost sight of the struggles faced by the local homeless community. It was this unwavering awareness that led her to establish Operation Helping Hands, a 501(c)(3) organization committed to assisting the homeless and those facing housing insecurity.

Through collaborative efforts with Southern California Community Colleges, OHH annually provides stipends and direct financial support to students, alleviating the burden of housing insecurity and enabling them to concentrate on their educational aspirations.



When OHH decided to focus some of their efforts on the local community college system, they were surprised by the challenges and resistance they faced. Once the OHH team was introduced to the Santa Ana College Foundation, there seemed to be a natural alignment in values and a shared mission to elevate this work together. Thus, Operation Helping Hands and Kim commenced their scholarship contributions in 2021, awarding \$12,000 annually to a deserving student who disclosed housing insecurity in their scholarship application. Given the high cost of living in Orange County, this annual high impact scholarship is a significant direct financial resource that has been proven to create stability in the lives of these scholarship recipients. Motivated by the determination exhibited by Santa Ana College students to surmount their obstacles to pursue higher education, Kim and OHH intensified their commitment. Presently, they award two scholarships annually at \$12,000 each, totaling \$24,000. This unique and first of its kind scholarship addresses the balance between the students' academic goals and the barrier that housing insecurity places on them.

We extend our heartfelt appreciation to Operation Helping Hands & Kim Valentine for their unwavering dedication to empowering Santa Ana College students. Their mentorship and financial support have profoundly transformed lives, enabling students to forge a brighter future.
