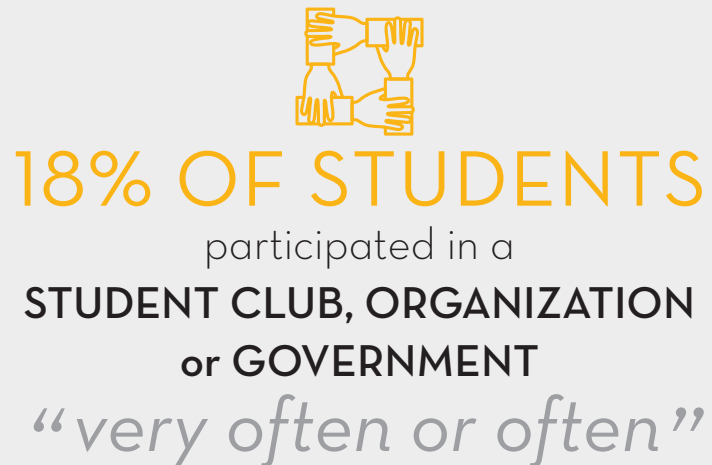

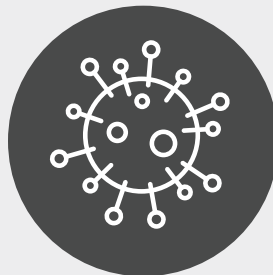

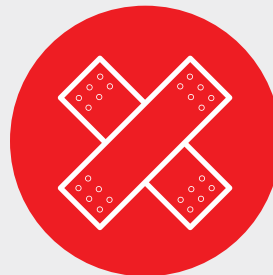

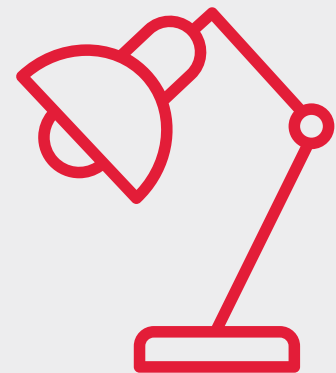

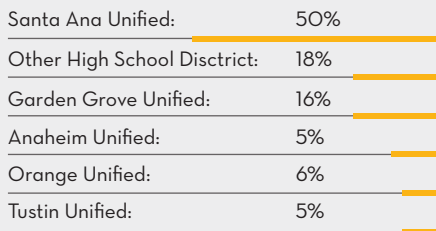

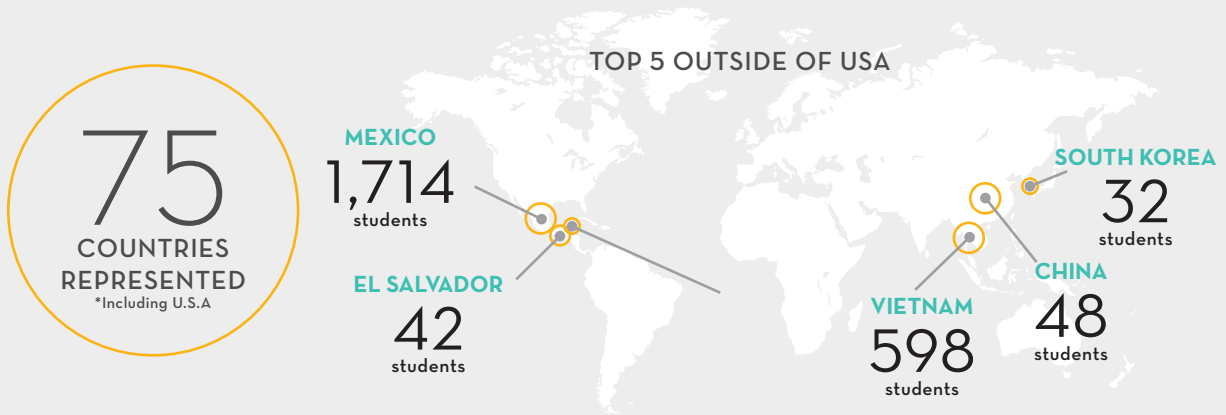

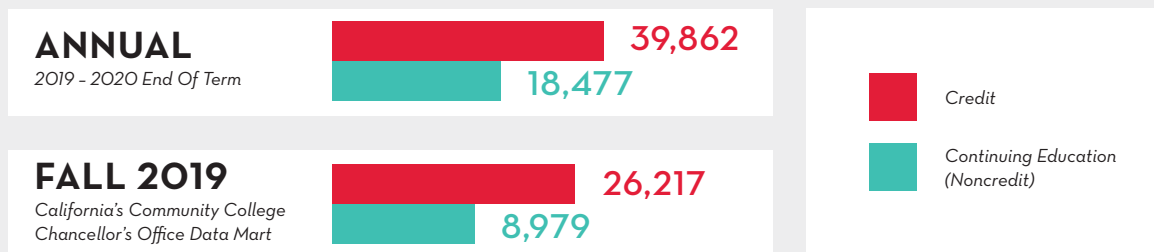

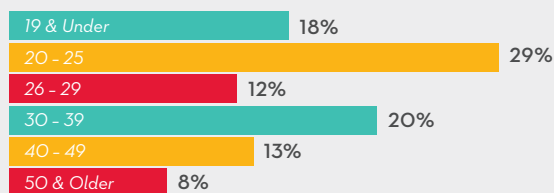

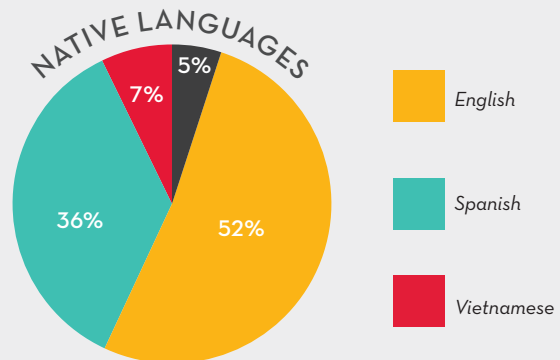

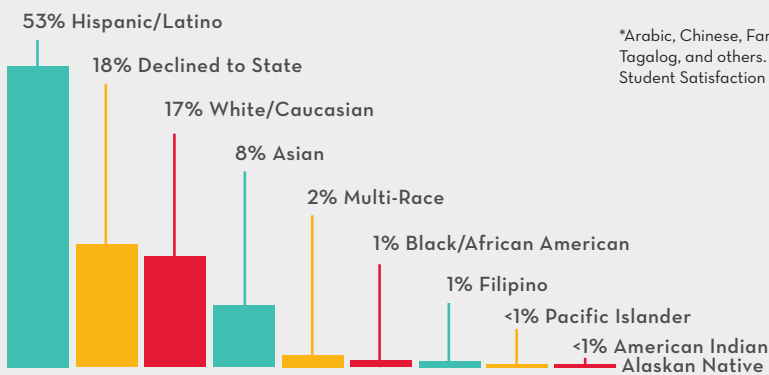

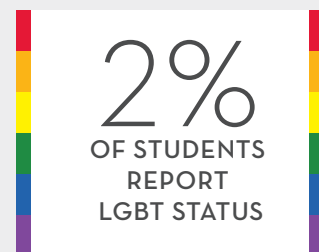
AGE DISTRIBUTION



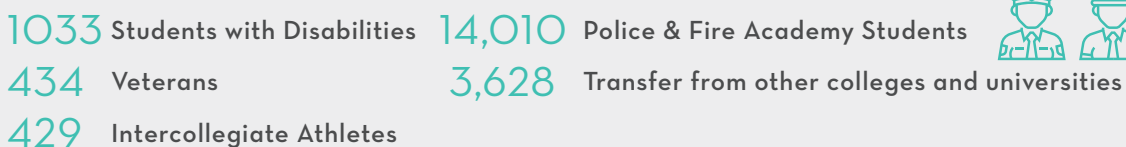

RACE/ETHNICITY DISTRIBUTION

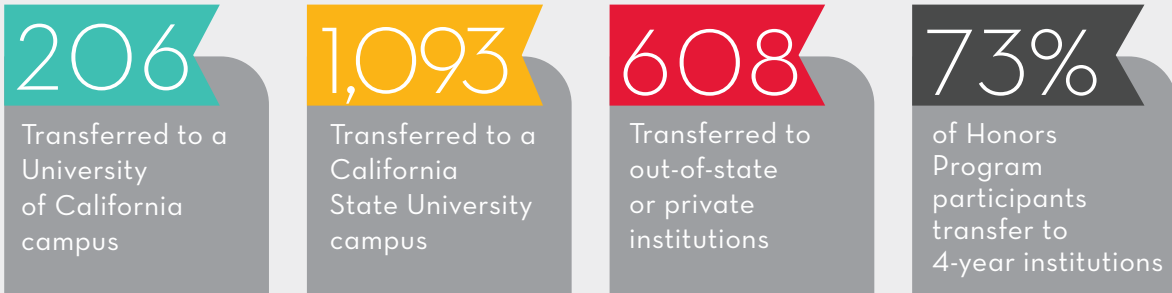

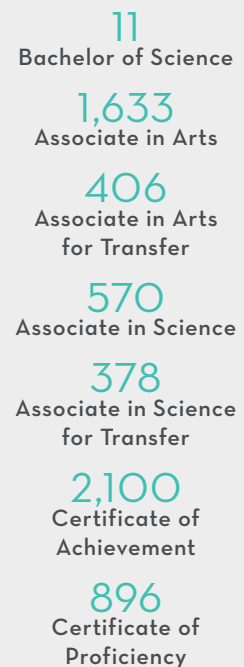
