- V. <u>Information Item</u> RAR Workgroup Update/Follow-up Budget Summit Spring 2017 Gabe Shweiri Presented information concerning the goals and outcomes of the RAR subcommittee. Explanation of RARs, the process and its flow, and how they fit into departmental budgets. Best practice guidelines were created for RAR process, which includes a faculty member from each division who will be at the RAR prioritization meeting with the VP of Academic Affairs. Discussion followed.
- VI. Action Item First Reading: SAC's Integrated SSSP, Student Equity and BSI plan
  George Sweeney presented description and explanation of the plan. The state of
  California has brought forth 3 initiatives: 1. Basic Skills Initiative 2. SSSP 3. Student
  Equity. SAC's plan is an integrated one to have all 3 in order to help students succeed.
  George highlighted the goals and stressed the goals are long-term. Please review and bring
