

HOW TO CLAIM CREDIT FOR ARTICULATED COURSES

3 EASY STEPS:



Bring your High School/ROP Completion of Articulation Course form if you received a "B" or higher in the course(s) <u>signed</u> by your ROP/High School instructor to the Career Education Office at SAC in VL-204.



Bring your High School transcripts (official or unofficial) showing the grade received for the course (usually 2 semesters).



Register in at least one class at SAC or SCC for the current semester.

ONCE YOU COMPLETE THE PROCESS, "CREDIT BY EXAM" UNITS WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT. NO LETTER GRADE IS GIVEN



REMEMBER: YOU HAVE 2 YEARS AFTER COMPLETING THE COURSE TO CLAIM CREDIT
