SEMESTER ONE YEAR ONE	RN 101 (4.5) RN 101L (5.0) RN 103 (3.0) RN 112 (1.5)	F, S F, S F, S, SU F, S, SU	Prerequisites for RN 101, RN 101L, RN 112, and RN 103 are Biology 239, Biology 249, Biology 139 or 239, and English 101/101H with a minimum grade of C. Concurrent enrollment of RN 101 and RN 101L are required. Students are encouraged to take RN 112 and/or RN 103 just prior to admission to the Nursing Program.
SEMESTER TWO YEAR ONE	RN 102 (4.0), RN 102L (4.6)	F, S F, S	Prerequisites for RN 102 and RN 102L are completion of RN 101, RN 101L, RN 103, and RN 112 with a minimum grade of C. Concurrent enrollment of RN 102 and RN 102L are required.
SEMESTER THREE YEAR TWO	RN 201 (4.0), RN 201L (5.0)	F, S F, S	Prerequisites for RN 201 and RN 201L are completion of RN 102 and RN 102L with a minimum grade of C. Concurrent enrollment of RN 201 and RN 201L are required.
SEMESTER FOUR YEAR TWO	RN 202 (4.0), RN 202L (5.4)	F, S F, S	Prerequisites for RN 202 and RN 202L are completion of RN 201 and RN 201L with a minimum grade of C. Concurrent enrollment of RN 202 and RN 202L are required.
