

An Industry on the Move...



Opportunities for exercise physiologists are expanding at a faster-than-average rate of **10-14**%, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.



Kinesiology professionals in California earn approximately 7% more than the national average.



The average wage for fitness trainers in the LA/OC region is \$40,047, with self-employed trainers earning up to **\$60,000 or more** annually.





Exercise physiologists, fitness teachers, and recreational therapists are all considered "Bright Outlook Occupations" by career data aggregator O-Net Online.

Flexible Career Paths...

Things are moving fast in the exercise science field...and it's not just the athletes.

Demand for career-educated kinesiologists, fitness trainers, and recreational therapists is growing far ahead of workforce averages, with virtually all associated job titles meeting O-Net Online's criteria for "Bright Outlook" occupations. The future is especially bright in Orange County, where the abundance of gyms, school districts, health care facilities, and universities maintains an ongoing classroom-to-career pipeline.

Kinesiology students learn about the science of human movement, developing a career-relevant foundation in anatomy, physiology, therapy, nutrition, and safety. Santa Ana College grads go on to careers in sports medicine, fitness, and teaching, as well as bachelor-level programs within the CSU system and beyond.

- Fully Transferable... Students who complete the Associate in Arts for Transfer degree in Kinesiology are granted priority admission to the CSU Fullerton program.
- Future BUILT Facilities... SAC is home to a 22,000-square-foot Kinesiology Locker Room Complex, a strength training lab, and a circuit training fitness center.
- ACE the Exam... The Health & Physical Education department's Fitness Specialist program prepares students for the American Council on Exercise (ACE) and/or National Academy of Sports Medicine (NASM) certification exams.
