1. ASCCC Resolution Number 01.06: Department Organization

Spring 1987

Resolved that the Academic Senate support the concept of collegial decision-making in the review and evaluation of proposals which would change the organization or functions of specific departments within a college and/or district, and

Resolved that such proposals should be reviewed and approved by the appropriate faculty bodies, e.g. the department, the curriculum committee, and the academic senate.

- 2. Pages 5-12 of the <u>Local Senates Handbook</u> are an easy way to access the title 5 language and definitions of collegial consultation
- 3. Your local academic senate is directed per California Code of Regulations, Title 5, section 53200(c) to consult collegially on academic and professional matters.
- 4. Some relevant responsibilities of your AS as enumerated in the 10+1 (https://www.asccc.org/10 1) might include the following:
 - 4. **Educational and program development** (if the restructuring impacts academic programs or the creation, evaluation, or possible deactivation of academic programs)
 - 6. **District and college governance structures**, as related to faculty roles (are we talking about restructuring into different divisions/departments? In that case, will there be a change in the number/arrangement of chairs or division representatives that sit on other governance committees? If so, this applies).

There may be concerns related to #9 and #10 as well.
