Planning & Budget Report for Academic Senate meeting 5-11-2020

- SAC is asked to develop 2020-2021 budget that reflects 5% cut. This means ~\$3.7 million additional cut. SAC Budget office is working on this.
- 2. CARES Act money: SAC gets ~\$5.5 million; half goes directly to SAC students, half goes to SAC institution. Student Services is handling the half to students and granting \$\$ to students who apply and qualify. About \$900K has been distributed out to students. SAC is waiting for the half to institution and more guidelines about how to use it.
- 3. Enrollment for Spring 2020 is down compared to same timeline of Spring 2019 (~500 FTES less as of 5/5?)
- 4. Certain costs to re-open (e.g., PPE) may be reimbursable via FEMA or other agencies
