# Success Teams

Success Teams are integrated teams designed to support students as they progress through their programs here at Santa Ana College. Throughout Fall 2019, a Success Team associated with the Future Educators CAP has served as a pilot and helped to identify goals for improving student success and completion. At this time, the following Success Team goals and the respective assigned roles are as follows.

Business Analyst	Administrative Support ending on needs, success teams may have differing membership depending on personnel

## Success Teams

### First Year Implementation Plan

Fall 2020 new student enrollment is estimated to be about 3300-3600. A ratio of 200 to 300 students to a Success Team appears to be the most manageable. Therefore, Santa Ana College will require between 12 to 15 Success Teams.

#### Success Teams will be meeting 2x per month for 2 hours each.

Communication methods will be supported by available applications. Microsoft Teams or Starfish are the most likely applications.
