Students fully certified in CSU-GE are also qualified to receive a Certificate of Achievement in CSU-GE. Courses from other California Community Colleges or CSU campuses will be applied to the same GE area for which they were approved at the college where they were completed. Courses from other regionally accredited colleges and universities (which do not maintain a CSU-GE certification list) may also be considered for inclusion. Please see your counselor for additional information. Courses completed at foreign institutions are not acceptable. It is the student's responsibility to request certification by submitting a certification/certificate of achievement petition to the Admissions and Records Office prior to established deadlines.
