### WHO is eligible to enroll for Intersession classes?

- Continuing Students at SAC and SCC.
- New Students who have not submitted an application prior to December 11, 2006: Students should report directly to the first class meeting. Pending availability, students may be given an Add card by the instructor. Students must then apply in Admissions and take the Add card immediately to the Registration Area for processing.  
(NOTE: English, ESL, Math and Chemistry classes require placement testing.)

### HOW do I enroll for Intersession classes?

- Enroll by telephone or online (by computer), November 13, 2006 – December 22, 2006.  
(NOTE: College is closed for holidays, December 25, 2006 to January 1, 2007.)

### CAN I enroll for Intersession classes using the telephone system or computer?

- For help with enrollment by telephone, follow the instructions on page 18 of the class schedule (in print or online).

### PROBLEMS registering?

- Have you attended SAC or SCC during the Fall or Spring semesters of 2006?  
**No:** You need to submit an application prior to registering for classes—go to Admissions.  
**Yes:** Continue with the following questions.
- Are you using your Social Security Number as your student ID? Do you have a PERM ID #?
- Are you using the correct Action Code? (It is a 2-digit number followed by the # sign = 77#.)
