

# Special Accommodations

The Testing Center offers an accessible distraction-free testing environment.

Accommodations such as extended time and/or use of adaptive computer Technology for reading tests such as Kurzweil are provided for students with documented disabilities

Alternative assessment procedures are provided for persons with impaired sensory, manual or speaking skills who cannot take the college placement tests under standard conditions, placement tests are available in Braille.

Requests for special accommodations should be made at the time an appointment is scheduled for a placement or Ability to Benefit test. Appointments are required for use of assisted devices such as Kurzweil. Also appointments are recommended for tests requiring accommodations other than extended time and/or a distraction free environment.

Instructors who have been notified by the Disabled Student Program and Services of a student's eligibility for special accommodations should document the accommodations requested on the Instructor Test Instruction Form used to deliver a test to the Testing Center.
