### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

#### Bachelor of Arts in Psychology (B.A. Psychology)

- An AA or AS degree from Santa Ana College/Santiago Canyon College, a regionally accredited institution of higher education
  1. *OR* minimum of **42 semester hours** of course work from regionally accredited institutions,
  2. *OR* appropriately certified international educational institutions, earning a grade of "C-" or better
- Successfully completed English 101 or equivalent, meeting three semester hours of English Composition coursework prior to enrollment, earning a grade of "C-" or better.
- A grade point average of 2.0 (4.0 scale) for all academic work completed.
- Proof of high school graduation or earned college degree

*If applicable: Minimum TOEFL score of 173 (computer version) or 500 (paper version) (required of applicants whose native language is not English or who have not graduated from an institution at which English is the language of instruction)*

*Remedial or developmental courses are not applicable to the 42 credit hour requirements.*

### TRANSFER CREDIT POLICY

- All students must take a minimum of 30 units in Psychology at Argosy University, including the Capstone Experience
- A maximum of 78 lower division or 90 total semester units may be transferred in.
- Transfer credit for prior college course work shall be applied as follows:
  - General Education Requirement (42 units may be transferred in).
  - General Electives (A maximum of 33 units may be transferred in).
  - Concentration Requirements (A maximum of 15 units may be transferred in.)
- A grade of "C-" or better is required for each course transferred in. Or, completion of an AA or AS degree from regionally accredited college. The AA or AS degree transfers in its entirety, including "D" grades, as long as cumulative GPA is 2.0 or better.
