Dear Ms. Begin,

Students coming to The University of Arizona from your two institutions will be able to substitute your institution's coursework for the first-year Composition Requirement here at UA.

Your English 101 is equivalent to our English 101.

Your English 102 *OR* English 103 *OR* Philosophy 110 will suffice for our English 102.

The information is entered into the Composition Board Equivalency List. If the student attends an Orientation, the course equivalencies should be made automatically within a few weeks. We do not yet receive automatic information from students who do not attend an Orientation. The students may access the University's Student Information System, then monitor the transcript on the Student Link from the UA webpage. If those credits have been entered in the Student Information System but *not* labeled as "UA EQUIV," the student should call (520-621-3553), write, or come to the Composition Program's window in Modern Languages 380 to ask that the credits be labeled equivalent by our department. We require all transfer students to have at least 5 units of English, as determined by the UA registrar, so two of your 4-unit courses should be more than sufficient.

Thank you for your inquiry into our program here at The University of Arizona. I hope your students enjoy their time here.
