- 1.1 **CSUF:** Art 110, 111, 130 and 141 must be completed with a 3.0 or better grade-point average. Add six units of lower division studio electives. For Graphic Design and Entertainment Art/Animation concentrations add only three units. Visit www.assist.org for list of courses. CSUF also offers a Bachelor of Arts with concentrations in Art History, General Studio Art, and Teaching. See www.assist.org for course requirements.
- 1.2 **CSULB:** Drawing & Painting - Add one course selected from Art 151, 152, 160, or 161.
- 1.3 **CSULB:** Take Art 151 or 152.
- 1.4 **CSULB:** Add Art (130 or 131), and (Art 195 or Photography 180). Add six units from: Art 195, 130, 131, 121A, 151, 152, 128, 141, Photography 180.

1.5 **CSULB:** Take Art 160 (three units) or 131.

1.6 **CSULB:** Add Art 195 or Photography 180.
