- 1.1 **CSUF:** No upper division credit will be awarded for Dance 100. A challenge exam may be required.
- 1.2 **CSUF:** Take Dance (201B or 213), plus Dance (209 or 210), plus Dance (206A or 206B).
- 1.3 **CSUF:** With the approval of the appropriate CSUF departmental advisor, complete seven units of electives with at least one course or sequence from each category: I. Take Computer Science 100, or Dance (220 or 221), or (215A or 215B), or 216, or Music 101, or Theatre Arts 100, 110, or choose upper division courses at CSUF. II. Take Theatre Arts 140, or (132 and 135), or choose upper division courses at CSUF. See CSUF catalog for additional information.
- 2.1 **UCI:** Choose one course from Dance 110, 111, 112, 113A, 113B, 120, 215A, 215B, or 216.
- 2.2 **UCI:** All students are required to audition for enrollment in the major and for appropriate placement level in ballet, jazz, and modern dance performance. It is strongly recommended that students have dance technique experience in preparation for placement auditions. The department offers a Bachelor of Arts in Dance, and a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance. See www.assist.org for additional information.
- 2.3 **UCI:** For B.F.A. Choreography and Performance specialization add Theatre Arts 110. For B.F.A. Choreography specialization add Theatre Arts 133. See www.assist.org for additional unit requirement for this specialization.

- 3.1 **CSULB:** The department offers Bachelor of Arts in Dance, Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance, and a BA in Dance with an option in Dance Science. For BFA select three units from: Art 101, 102, Theatre Arts 105, 110, Music 101 or select another option after transfer. For BA with Dance Science option take Biology 239 and 249.
- 3.2 **CSULB:** Students wishing to major in Dance must audition for placement prior to starting the program. Applicants should contact the Department of Dance at CSULB to obtain audition dates and audition application form at 1-562-985-4747.

The major preparation listed above ONLY includes courses for which articulation exists. This information is based upon university course articulation and catalog information available at the time of publication. It is to be used as a guide for lower division preparation for the major and not as an official document. **It is the student's responsibility to check the current catalog and articulation for any additional course requirements, or for any changes which may occur.
