- 1.1 **CPP:** Add English 101H or 103. This is a major in Sociology with a Social Work Subplan. It provides preparation for professional studies in social work as well as entry into other fields.
- 2.1 **CSUF:** In lieu of Psychology 361 at CSUF. No upper division credit. Take either Human Development 107 or Psychology 157.
- 2.2 **CSUF:** In lieu of Human Services 315 at CSUF. No upper division credit.
- 2.3 **CSUF:** Take Psychology 250 or Sociology 112 in lieu of Sociology 351 or Psychology 341 at CSUF. No upper division credit.
- 2.4 **CSUF:** Community college transfer students may apply a maximum of twelve units of course work in human services and related fields towards the total of fifty-four units. For transfer students who have completed an approved Alcohol and Drugs or Eating Disorder Certificate Program or Special Education Paraprofessional Certificate at local community colleges, the CSUF Human Services program will accept up to 18 units of transfer credit for majors in the program. - 2.5 **CSUF:** For Special Education Credential Program, students should see www.assist.org for SAC course selections for this major.
- 2.6 **CSUF:** This is a major in Sociology with a social work concentration. It provides preparation for professional studies in social work as well as entry into other fields. A total of nine CSUF advisor approved units from a community college can be applied to the major.

- 3.1 **CSULB:** This program accepts applicants for Fall term only. The Social Work program has been designated as impacted by the California State University. See the CSULB catalog and the web site www.csulb.edu/depts/enrollment/admissions/impacted_major.html for information about admission under impactation.
- 4.1 **UCI:** Add Psychology 240 or 250. The School of Social Ecology offers a general interdisciplinary degree in Social Ecology (See requirements above) in addition to separate degree programs in Criminology, Law and Society; Psychology and Social Behavior; Public Health Policy; and Public Health Sciences. See www.assist.org for course requirements for these programs.
