- 1.1 **SAC:** Nursing majors may take Biology 139 or 229. Biology 139 does not meet the RN prerequisite for some universities. (See above.) Science courses must have been completed within 5 years prior to the student being added to the entry list for the Nursing Program.
- 1.2 **SAC:** Add English 101. Consult the SAC website or the SAC Counseling Center for additional requirements and the latest admission information.
- 2.1 **CSUF:** Take Anthropology 100 or Sociology 100.
- 2.2 **CSUF:** Take Biology 139 or 229. Biology 229 is preferred.
- 2.3 **CSUF:** Take Biology 149 or 239. Biology 239 is preferred.
- 2.4 **CSUF:** Take Chemistry 119 or 209 or 219.
- 2.5 **CSUF:** Above requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Current licensure as a registered nurse in California is required for admission. Completion of one year of satisfactory work experience as a registered nurse is recommended.
- 2.6 **CSUF:** Take Biology 139 or 229.
- 2.7 **CSUF:** Add one course from Math 105, 140, 219, 170, 150, 180 or Social Science 219. Science courses must have been completed within 5 years prior to entering the program. Cumulative minimum GPA of 2.75 required; and minimum 2.5 GPA in the Pre-Nursing prerequisites with a "C" or better in each course. TEAS exam with a minimum composite score of 74% required.

- 3.1 **CSULB:** Two Bachelor of Science degrees in Nursing are offered; one for those who already hold an RN, and one for those who do not ("Basic student"). The number of applicants to Nursing (Basic) exceeds the number that can be accepted. For this reason Nursing (Basic) applicants are subject to criteria in addition to those required for admission to the university. Students holding an RN should contact the Nursing Department at CSULB regarding course requirements.
- 3.2 **CSULB:** Basic students take Biology (139 or 229) 239 and 249. Students transferring without an RN – take Biology 239 and 249.
- 4.1 **UCI:** Add Biology 211, and Chemistry 229 and 249. Biology 211 and Chemistry 219, 229, and 249 must be completed with a grade of "B" or better. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered. Additional Biology coursework is required for admission. Students are strongly urged to contact the UCI Nursing Science Program Office at (949) 824-1514 for further information.

The major preparation listed above ONLY includes courses for which articulation exists. This information is based upon university course articulation and catalog information available at the time of publication. It is to be used as a guide for lower division preparation for the major and not as an official document. **It is the student's responsibility to check the current catalog and articulation for any additional course requirements, or for any changes which may occur.
