| <p>1.1 CPP: Add Economics 120 or 121.</p> <p>2.1 CSUF: The major consists of 39 units of Political Science. Political Science 101 is not part of the major but is a prerequisite to further work in Political Science at CSUF. Not more than twelve units total (CSUF's Political Science 200, plus nine other units) may be in the lower division.</p> <p>3.1 CSULB: Three lower division units (and fifteen upper division units) must be taken in a chosen area of concentration. Concentrations are: Law, Politics and Policy; Political Theory; and Global Politics. For Global Politics take Political Science 201 and 220 to meet both the lower division concentration and lower division breadth requirements.</p> | <p>4.1 UCI: Take one year of statistics at UCI or Math 180, and 219 or Social Science 219 at SAC.</p> <p>4.2 UCI: Add Computer Science (112 and 121) or select another course after transfer. Majors select either Option A or B. For <i>Option A</i> 1) take one course from: Political Science 101, 201, 220. 2) take one additional course in Political Science (not taken above) from Political Science 101, 200, 201, 220. 3) take one additional course in Political Science (not taken above) or in another social science discipline from Anthropology 100, 101, 103, 104, 105, 108, 125, Asian American Studies 101, Chicano Studies 101, Economics 120, 121, English 104, Ethnic Studies 101, 102, Geography 100, 101, 102, Interdisciplinary Studies 117H, Political Science 101, 200, 201, 220, Psychology 100, 140, 157 (or Human Development 107) 200, 219, 240, 250, Social Science 219, Sociology 100, 140, 240. For <i>Option B</i> 1) Take three courses from Political Science 101, 201, 220 or select another course after transfer. 2) take two additional course in Political Science (not taken above) from Political Science 101, 201, 200, 220. 3) See option A, #3.</p> |
