

# GPA Calculator

To determine your "transferable" GPA, (have a copy of your transcript in front of you):

- Enter the term in which course was taken
- Followed by the course name & number
  - For CSU: Enter ONLY all courses numbered 100 and above
  - For UC: refer to the "UC Transferable Course Sheet" for approved courses
- Enter the unit value
- Enter grade points earned

DO NOT count courses which:

- you have repeated (count only the higher grade)  
(note: some schools average grades for repeated courses)
- you received "credit / no credit"
- you withdrew.

Your GPA will automatically be calculated for you.

Grade	Grade Points for every 1 unit
A .....	4
B .....	3
C .....	2
D .....	1
F .....	0

**Example:**  
 3 unit course, earned a "B" grade  
 $3 \times 3 = 9$  grade points  
 $9 \div 3 = \mathbf{3.0\ GPA}$

Term	Course	Units Completed	Grade Points
<i>Fall 2005</i>	<i>ENGL 101</i>	<i>4</i>	<i>16</i>

### IMPORTANT

UC: Transferable courses as accepted by campuses within the University of California, such as, Irvine, Riverside and Los Angeles, are limited to those articulated in the "UC Transferable Courses".

CSU: Transferable courses as accepted by campuses within the California State University system, such as Fullerton, Long Beach, Dominguez Hills and Los Angeles, are limited to those courses numbered 100 and above.
