|  | SPANISH 213 (3) Elective | FALL ONLY | The prerequisite for SPAN 213 is SPAN 201, concurrent enrollment in SPAN 201, or 3 years of High School Spanish with a grade of C or better. |

| SPRING SEMESTER YEAR TWO | SPANISH 202 (5) Required | SPRING ONLY | The prerequisite for SPAN 202 is SPAN 201 or 4 years of High School Spanish with a grade of $C$ or better. |
|  | SPAN 195a/195b (3) Elective | Fall and Spring | The prerequisite for SPAN 195a is SPAN 102 or 3 years of High School Spanish with a grade of C or better. <br> The prerequisite for SPAN 195b is SPAN 195a with a grade of $C$ or better. |

IMPORTANT NOTE: Based on state regulations, students who come to SAC with credit for Spanish 101 and 102 (or 2 and 3 years of High School Spanish respectively) must take the equivalent of 10 units from the following list of possible substitution courses, including another language:

SPANISH 195a, 195b, 213; ITALIAN 120, 121; FRENCH 101, 102; CHINESE 101, 102; JAPANESE 101, 102; VIETNAMESE 101, 102; History 105, 124; Anthropology 105; English 102, 103; Philosophy 110; Communications 101.
