



Creating a Google Account and YouTube Channel

Go to the Google site: accounts.google.com to create a **gmail** account if you do not already have one.








Clicking your profile icon on the top right corner reveals a drop down menu. Select **my channel**.




Click the **create channel button**.




You may customize your channel




by adding photos or graphics to the page heading area. Click the **Add Channel Art** and then **drag** the graphic into the heading area.
