AmeriCorps is a national service program dedicated to building young leaders, serving disadvantaged communities, increasing job skills, and providing opportunities to earn money for education. AmeriCorps works to meet the needs of each individual in terms of education and training, including those with low reading and math skills. AmeriCorps members are assigned to non-profits, government agencies, institutions, and community-based organizations. In exchange for their 10 months of service, members receive over \$6,000 for college or to pay off existing student loans, student loan deferment, living allowances, health benefits, college credit, and new job skills.

AmeriCorps offers two Federal programs for 18 to 24 year olds including the NCCC Traditional Corps (Civilian Conservation Corps) and the FEMA Corps, which is focused on response to natural disasters. For those 18 and over with existing leadership skills (no upper age restriction) there is a Team Leader option for NCCC and FEMA. Team Leaders manage groups of 8 to 10 young adults. All programs are open to citizens of any U.S. state or territory.
