BILINGUAL EDUCATOR APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (BEAP)

This 24-month registered apprenticeship provides comprehensive support to preservice professionals, combining on-the-job learning and coursework at Santa Ana College. Students will take college classes towards earning a school age certificate while also getting paid to work at one at Santa Ana Unified School District in the Engage 360* after school program with students in TK-6th Grade. Students must have the legal right to work in the United States, must be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license, and must be willing to have a health screening/TB assessment and required immunizations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Interested in working with Children 5 Years-12 years old
- Willing to enroll in child development and general education classes
- The legal right to work in the US
- 18 years of age with valid driver's license
- Willing to have a health screening/TB Assessment and Required Immunizations
