EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (ECEAP)

This 18-month registered apprenticeship provides comprehensive support to preservice professionals, combining on-the-job learning and coursework at Santa Ana College. Students will take college classes towards earning an Early Childhood Education teaching credential (Child Development Teacher Permit), the teaching credential required to work in a state funded program (such as in a school district) or a federally funded program (Head Start) while also getting paid to work at one of our child development centers. Students must have the legal right to work in the United States, must be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license, and must be willing to have a health screening/TB assessment and required immunizations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Interested in working with Young Children (6 months - 5 Years old)
- Willing to enroll in child development and general education classes
- The legal right to work in the US
- 18 years of age with valid driver's license
- Willing to have a health screening/TB Assessment and Required Immunizations
