I began my fire service career in 1987 with the City of Costa Mesa where I served as a Fire Inspector, Public Educator, Public Information Officer, Plans Examiner, and Acting Fire Marshal. At Santa Ana College, I have served as both a Fire Technology Instructor and Fire Officer Program Coordinator. I have also served on State Fire Training curriculum development and peer assessment (PACE) committees. Today I teach a wide variety of fire service classes, am a frequent speaker at both education and fire service conferences and serve as the Fire Technology Club Advisor.

Educated locally, I attended McFadden Jr High in Santa Ana and graduated from Fountain Valley High School. I am an alumnus of Orange Coast College, Santa Ana College and CSU Long Beach, where I received a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and completed 38 units towards a Master's Degree in Occupational Education.

I am a proponent of "Brain-Based Learning". My favorite saying is "Education is not the filling of a vessel, but the kindling of a flame."- Socrates

My course content decisions are guided by the following learning principles:

- 1. All learning is physiological.
- 2. The Brain-Mind is social.
- 3. The search for meaning is innate.
- 4. The search for meaning occurs through patterning.
- 5. Emotions are critical to patterning.
- 6. The Brain-Mind processes parts and wholes simultaneously.
- 7. Learning involves both focused attention and peripheral perception.
- 8. Learning always involves conscious and unconscious processes.
- 9. There are at least two approaches to memory: archiving individual facts or skills or making sense of experience.
- 10. Learning is developmental.
- 11. Complex learning is enhanced by challenge and inhibited by threat associated with helplessness.
- 12. Each brain is uniquely organized

I hope that all of my students will leave my classes with new skills, questions that beg for more research, stories to tell others and a seed of an idea that will explode at some time in the future.

Courses taught: Introduction to Fire Protection; Fire Behavior; Fire Protection Systems and Equipment; and Fire Prevention Technology. I also teach the California State Fire Marshal certification classes: Introduction to the Fire Code; Inspection of Fire Protection Systems; Special Hazards; Flammable Liquids and Gases; Fire Protection Systems; Interpreting the IBC and CCR; Special Hazard Occupancies; Hydraulic Sprinkler Calculations; Plan Review; Fire Prevention 1 and Public Education 1: Systematic Planning and Communication Skills.
