### Subject-Specific OTA-Related Full-Text Databases

**Academic Search Complete** This comprehensive scholarly and multi-disciplinary full-text database includes more than 8,500 full-text periodicals, including more than 7,300 peer-reviewed journals. In addition to full text, this database offers indexing and abstracts for more than 12,500 journals and a total of more than 13,200 publications including monographs, reports, conference proceedings, etc. The database features PDF content going back as far as 1887.

**Gale Virtual Reference Library** The Gale Virtual Reference Library is an online collection of over 2,000 reference books. It provides articles on virtually any research topic. At an October 2014 Librarians' meeting Librarians agreed to purchase and catalog the online version of the *Gale Encyclopedia of Nursing and Allied Health*.

**EBSCO Electronic Books** A collection of electronic books (eBooks). Access a wide range of research, reference, and reading materials online from any location. Searchable across entire eBook collection or within a particular e-Book.

**CINAHL Plus** *CINAHL Plus* provides indexing for 4,500 journals from the fields of nursing and allied health, with indexing back to 1937. *CINAHL Plus* also contains searchable cited references for more than 1,340 journals. Full text material includes nearly 80 journals plus legal cases, clinical innovations, critical paths, drug records, research instruments and clinical trials.

**Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition** This database provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. *Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition* also features the Lexi-PAL Drug Guide, which covers 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names.

**MEDLINE** *MEDLINE* provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more. Created by the National Library of Medicine, *MEDLINE* uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) indexing with tree, tree hierarchy, subheadings and explosion capabilities to search citations from over 4,800 current biomedical journals.

**The American Journal of Occupational Therapy (AJOT)** This one-journal database provides topic, keyword, author, title and periodical issue access to *The American Journal of Occupational Therapy*, the "official publication of the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA), which is the "primary source for research on the effectiveness and efficiency of occupational therapy practice".

**Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection** *Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection* is a comprehensive database covering information concerning topics in emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational & experimental methods. This is the world's largest full text psychology database offering full text coverage for nearly 400 journals.
