

Bachelor of Science in Occupation Studies
Admission Criteria- Fall 2020

The OS program will be using a multi-criteria selection process, which will include an in-class writing sample. The writing sample will be completed in the T-210 on the Santa Ana Campus. Students will have 20 minutes to write 1-2 paragraphs to their choice of 1 of 2 questions. The writing samples will be scored for content and writing accuracy using an established rubric.

The selection process will use a point system as follows:

- Cumulative GPA from OTA Program
 - 3.5 – 4.0 = 50 points
 - 3.0 – 3.49 = 40 points
 - 2.5 – 2.99 = 30 points
 - 2.0 – 2.49 = 15 points
- Grade in highest level of math completed
 - Intermediate Algebra
 - A = 6 points
 - B = 4 points
 - C = 2 points
 - Statistics
 - A = 8 points
 - B = 6 points
 - C = 4 points
- Grade in anatomy and physiology
 - If taken as a combined course
 - A = 6 points
 - B = 4 points
 - C = 2 point
 - If taken separately or as two-part course (averaged between the two classes)
 - 3.5 - 4.0 = 8 points
 - 3.0 - 3.49 = 6 points
 - 2.5 – 2.99 = 4 points
 - 2.0 – 2.49 = 2 points
- Score on in-class writing – Max possible score = 40
