Concurrent enrollment of RN 164 and RN 164L are required.</p>

Concurrent enrollment of RN 261 and RN 261L are required.</p>
<p>SEMESTER FOUR YEAR TWO</p>	<p><u>First these courses for 12 weeks:</u> RN 263 – Complex Concepts (3.5) RN 263L – Complex Concepts Lab (2.5)</p> <p><u>Then these course for 4 weeks:</u> RN 264L – Preceptorship (2.5)</p>	<p>F, S F, S F, S</p>	<p>Prerequisites for RN 263 and RN 263L are completion of RN 261 and RN 261L with a minimum grade of C.
