Dear Nursing Program Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Santa Ana College Registered Nursing (RN) program. This packet contains the Santa Ana College Nursing Program's multi-criteria admission process information and application instructions, along with the Registered Nursing Multi-Criteria Application itself. The application process for entering first semester in Spring 2024 will be accomplished through email and using **copies** of official transcripts. **Please read the instructions very carefully.**

Attention: <u>Licensed Psychiatric Technicians</u> must meet with the Program Director or designee to determine placement and attach letter indicating permission to enter first semester.

SELECTION:

Proportionally, the Students invited to enter will be selected based on:

- 20% of the available admission spaces for Spring 2024 will be filled with randomly selected students from the qualified applicants.
- 75% of the available admission spaces for Spring 2024 will be filled with students with the highest number of points. In the case of a tie in points, a lottery will be conducted. An additional 20 students will be selected as alternates.
- 5% of the available admission spaces for Spring 2024 will be filled with students who are re-entering the program.
- Applicants who are not selected for entry are encouraged to re-apply during the next application period (February 1, 2024 – February 15, 2024) for possible entry into Fall 2024. We do NOT maintain a waiting list for first semester entry.

ACCEPTANCE:

- Notification of Acceptance will be e-mailed no later than the week of November 27, 2023.
 You must contact the Health Sciences/Nursing Office by December 8, 2023 by e-mail
 (nursing2@sac.edu), or by phone (714-564-6825) to confirm that you will be taking one of
 the available spaces in Spring 2024. The notification letter will include information about two
 mandatory orientations.
 - The first mandatory orientation will be on December 12, 2023 from 9am to 12pm, via Zoom.
 - The second mandatory orientation is TBA in January 2024 from 9am to 3pm, in room TBA/Zoom.

- 2. Acceptance to the nursing program is tentative until:
 - You obtain/reactivate a Santa Ana College student I.D. number by applying to the college.

AND

 Official transcripts from ALL colleges/universities are received by Admissions and Records

AND

 Official transcripts from high school showing graduation date are received by Admissions and Records, unless the college/university transcript shows a posted degree on the transcript.

AND

- Official TEAS Version 7/HESI/PAX-RN score sheet (results) is received by the Nursing Office.
 - ⇒ To send official TEAS results to the Nursing Office, applicants must contact ATI at www.atitesting.com to have official transcripts sent to "Santa Ana College ADN" (unless you tested at Santa Ana College).
 - ⇒ To send official HESI results to the Nursing Office, applicants must contact Elsevier at https://evolve.elsevier.com to have official transcripts sent to Santa Ana College Nursing Office.
 - ⇒ To send official PAX-RN results to the Nursing Office, applicants must contact the National League for Nursing at www.nln.org and select "Testing Services," to have official results sent to Santa Ana College Nursing Office.

AND

 Official AP scores from the College Board are received by Admissions and Records, if applicable.

AND

 Official evaluated international transcripts are received by Admissions and Records, if applicable.

These requirements must be met by January 5, 2024 or <u>an alternate will be invited to enter</u> the SAC Nursing Program in your place.

STEP 1: QUALIFICATIONS

ALL CHECKED = ELIGIBLE.

To be eligible to apply for admission to the nursing program, you must:
☐ Be at least 18 years of age at the time of admission.
AND
Have <u>COMPLETED</u> the Nursing Program prerequisites or equivalents from a SAC recognized accredited institution: Anatomy (BIOL 239), Physiology (BIOL 249), Microbiology (BIOL 139 or BIOL 229) and Freshman Composition (English 101 or 101H).
⇒ Science prerequisites must have been completed within the last 7 years (completed not earlier than Fall 2017). Each science course must be passed with a grade of "C" or higher (a grade of "Pass" will be allowed for classes taken in Spring 2020-Fall 2021) and the combined GPA of the science courses must be 2.5 or higher. If the combined sciences' GPA is under 2.5, you are NOT eligible to apply.
⇒ Freshman Composition (English 101 or 101H) must be from a United States institution and must be passed with a grade of "C" or higher (a grade of "Pass" will be allowed for classes taken in Spring 2020-Fall 2021).
AND
Have passed the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) ATI TEAS Version 7 with a score of at least 62% or higher on the first attempt, after documented remediation, or after one year from the previous attempt. HESI and PAX-RN results may be accepted if the results indicate an equivalent score and tested in equivalent subject areas in one sitting. Note: ATI TEAS Version 7 (HESI or PAX-RN) results are accepted within 365 days from a previous attempt only if there is also documented remediation due to having failed the test.
⇒ Attach unofficial TEAS results; do NOT have official results sent to Santa Ana College, unless you are notified that you have been accepted and directed to do so.

If you checked all 3 boxes above, you are eligible to apply to Santa Ana College's Nursing Program's First Semester that will begin in Spring of 2024.

STEP 2: FILL OUT THE APPLICATION

READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY AND FULLY.

Print the application Cover Sheet and Form; confirming you have the application for entry to Spring 2024 (*Applications with other dates will be disqualified*).

Complete the Cover Sheet with your name. Complete the Application Form including your signature that attests to all answers being true.

The Application Parts:

- Part A. PERSONAL INFORMATION
- Part B. NAMES OF COLLEGES / UNIVERSITIES ATTENDED. If there is not enough room, please attach an additional page. Please spell out the name of all colleges; DO NOT use acronyms.
- Part C. PREREQUISITE INFORMATION Science prerequisites:
 - \Rightarrow Calculate your combined sciences GPA by assigning points as follows: A=4, B=3, C=2, P=2;

Add the total number of points for the science courses and divide by 3. For example: Anatomy was a B (3), Physiology was an A (4), Microbiology was P (2) = 9 divided by 3 = 3.0 Science GPA.

(If you completed two combined Anatomy/Physiology classes [required to be taken at the same institution] use the "anatomy" section to fill in your 1^{st} semester of A&P information and then use the "physiology" section to fill out your 2^{nd} semester of A&P information.)

Your combined sciences GPA **must** be at least 2.5 for you to be eligible to apply.

Part D. POINTS

- \Rightarrow Place a checkmark next to any category for which you are qualified to receive points.
- ⇒ Enter your points for that category in the column labeled "My Points."
- ⇒ Total your points for your own reference. The evaluators will review all attached documents and determine the number of points.
- Part E. Sign and date your application.

STEP 3:

ATTACH SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Read the following carefully and fully.

You need to scan (PDF or Word Doc) and attach the following legible documents:

1. Copy of OFFICIAL* high school <u>graduation transcripts</u> (not a diploma) or Copy of OFFICIAL* GED results (graduation transcripts or GED results are not needed if you have a college degree showing on your college transcripts).

*High school transcripts MUST have the following (nothing can be handwritten/typed in): your name, school's full name and graduation date.

- Copy of AP scores from The College Board IF you have received college course credit from your AP scores. <u>Your name</u> must be on your AP transcript. <u>Note, AP Credit will not</u> be taken from HS or College transcripts (official AP transcript will be required, if selected).
- Copy of OFFICIAL transcripts from accredited United States' colleges/universities you
 have attended (<u>including</u> official Santa Ana College / Santiago Canyon College).
 Official sealed transcripts will be required if selected.
 - If the course was not completed in the state of California, include a copy of the course or syllabus.
 - International transcripts must be evaluated by a Regionally Accredited Evaluation Company. A copy of the official evaluation is to be submitted (sealed official evaluation will be required, if selected).

*College/university transcripts MUST have the following (nothing can be handwritten/typed in): **your name**, **school's full name** and **graduation date**, if applicable.

ALL transcripts must be scanned (PDF or Word Doc), attached, and emailed with your application, otherwise your application will be considered incomplete and will be disqualified.

- 4. Copy of your results page from atitesting.com ATI TEAS Version 7 (or HESI or PAX-RN) with your name listed on the form. Do NOT have ATI send your scores for your application. If your results are not attached, your application will be considered incomplete and will be disqualified. Official transcript will be required, if selected.
- 5. Other supporting documentation, if applicable. Refer to the application checklist to verify what is considered acceptable documentation.

YOU MAY PROCEED TO THE NEXT STEP

STEP 4: SUBMIT THE APPLICATION

You must **submit** ONE EMAIL containing your coversheet, pages 1-4 of application, supporting documentation, and transcripts as attachments in **PDF** or **Word Doc** between the dates and times of **September 1**, **2023**, **at 12:00 AM** and no later than **11:59 PM** on **September 15**, **2023**.

Your application must be completed and signed with all the materials attached or your application will be disqualified. It is up to you to ensure that all documents are attached. If you have submitted your application but need to add something, a new complete application with all the supporting documentation must be emailed before the deadline. The previous submission and all supporting documentation will be voided and the new submission will be reviewed and evaluated.

You must email your application, supporting documentation, and transcripts in <u>PDF or Word Doc - JPEG will NOT be accepted.</u>

DO NOT submit Nursing Application and supporting documents to SAC Admissions and Records, as they are not evaluating your SAC Nursing Application.

A)	Application Email all documents required for the Registered Nursing Program Student Application. Application must be completed accurately, honestly, and signed. Confirm the application being submitted is for entry to Spring 2024 ; other applications will be disqualified.
B)	Copy of OFFICIAL High School/GED Transcripts. Your name, school's full name, and graduation date must be on the transcripts (not hand-written/typed in). If applicable, AP scores from The College Board must be included. Upon acceptance to the program, official AP scores and HS/GED transcripts must be received in Admissions and Records by January 5, 2024.
C)	Copy of OFFICIAL Colleges/Universities Transcripts — please include any pertinent schools attended (if you have a college degree showing on your college transcripts, then the high school/GED transcripts are not required). Your name, school's full name, and graduation date must be on the transcripts (not hand-written/typed in), no ACRONYMS. Diplomas are not accepted. If applicable, copy of official evaluated international transcripts must be included. Upon acceptance to the program, all official evaluated international transcripts must be received in Admissions and Records by January 5, 2024.
D)	Copy of results page from atitesting.com Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) ATI TEAS Results Version 7 (HESI and PAX-RN will be accepted) – Do NOT have official results sent (they will not be considered). Submit results of:

E)	St. Joseph Hospital Employment Verification (if applicable) Pertains to St. Joseph Hospital of Orange and St. Joseph Heritage employees only. Current letter (within one month of submission) on letterhead from Human Resources confirming at least 6 months current employment and a copy of your employee badge are required. St. Joseph Hospital of Orange and St. Joseph Heritage employees are given prioritization for no more than 10 spaces annually and will be placed into the Extended Campus Program.
F)	Proof of Relevant Work Experience (if applicable) Letter on letterhead from Human Resources stating number of hours, dates and years of employment (within 3 years) with title and duties described.
G)	Veteran status (if applicable) Copy of DD-214 showing above a dishonorable discharge.
H)	Statement of Relevant Life Experience (if applicable) Letter to identify and describe the life experience(s) being claimed.
l)	Refugee Status (if applicable) Copy of an I-94 Arrival/Departure Card.
J)	Low Family Income (if applicable) Evidence of fee waivers or CalWORKs recipient within the last 3 years, current student Financial Aid letter, or EFC ≤ \$4995, with your name and the school name listed.
K)	Proficiency in a Second Language (if applicable) Letter in English stating fluency (speaking, reading, and writing) in another language and explaining how fluency was obtained.
