
◆DAY 1 ~ CENTRAL COAST BY RAIL◆

From our departure points this morning we will travel by motorcoach to the Oxnard train station. Then, board Amtrak's Coast Starlight and travel by train to San Luis Obispo allowing you to see much of the California coast that is hidden from the roads traveled by car. Enjoy lunch in the dining car, enjoy the views from the observation car, or take a nap at your seat. Upon our arrival in San Luis Obispo, we'll continue our journey to Carmel by motorcoach. Our accommodations for three nights is at a quaint inn situated in the coastal town of Carmel. This charming and stylish property offers an array of gracious amenities including a heated pool and a spacious hot tub. This evening an included welcome dinner at a local favorite. (Dinner)



DAY 2 ~ GILROY GARLIC FESTIVAL

After an included breakfast at our hotel this morning, we will travel through the beautiful countryside to the town of Gilroy for the annual Gilroy Garlic Festival. This is the 36th year of this celebration of garlic which has grown to become one of the largest food festivals in the U.S. While today is opening day, it is also the least crowded of the three-day event. Spend your time at leisure sampling a unique combination of food including garlic ice cream, garlic scones, garlic chocolate and other garlic delights. Enjoy the entertainment, arts & crafts and a variety of activities. Pick up some new recipes and watch the great garlic cook-off. Your taste buds won't know what hit them during this fun and fragrant culinary experience. We return to Monterey this afternoon with time at your leisure in downtown Monterey and Cannery Row. The ocean canyon surrounding Monterey Bay is deeper than the Grand Canyon and harbors a rich variety of sea life, which can be seen up-close this afternoon on an optional excursion to the world-famous Monterey Bay Aquarium. Here you can explore the hidden world of this spectacular ocean realm at the heart of the nation's largest marine sanctuary. Enjoy dinner at leisure in downtown Carmel. DAY 3 ~ SANTA CRUZ

ered bridge. Then, it's all aboard a 100-year-old steam train for a ride through towering California Redwoods. When this same route opened in 1875 it carried lumber as well as picnickers and tourists to the redwoods and Santa Cruz. This grove of redwoods, part of Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park, was the first grove of coastal redwoods, that was set aside for preservation back in 1867. After traveling down the scenic San Lorenzo River Gorge, across a 1909 steel truss bridge and through an 1875 tunnel, we'll arrive at the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk. Enjoy time for lunch on own and browsing at leisure along the Boardwalk - one of California's great summer destinations. We return to Carmel this afternoon with the balance of the day at leisure to enjoy this coastal town or take a walk on the beach. (Breakfast)

•DAY 4 ~ SOLVANG, JOURNEY HOME •

This morning, following an included breakfast at our hotel, we begin our journey home. We'll make a stop this afternoon in **Solvang** for time at leisure for lunch and browsing. When visiting Solvang you enter the "Danish Capital of America." Quaint old-world architectural styles blend with flower-lined streets to create a walkable village. Wonderful shops offer imported European wares and collectibles, and the delicious bakeries and restaurants are a delight. We'll return home this evening with the sights, smells and memories of our journey to Carmel, Gilroy and Santa Cruz forever ingrained in our minds. (Breakfast)
