- II. Updates, Debriefs, and Next Steps: Guided Pathways Coordinator: Stephanie Clark
  - A. Success Teams Summit – May 8<sup>th</sup>
    - i. The Pilot Success Team for Future Educators paneled a webinar in which team members presented their work, successes and plans as a success team.
    - ii. There was an orientation portion for Success Team Members who volunteered.
    - iii. The panelists highlighted the excitement and the work required to accomplish several goals as a team
    - iv. Shared an approach on how to assist students with first year English and Math
    - v. Gregory Gonzales and Matthew Bitner have been added as Success Team Members
  - B. GP Forum – May 13<sup>th</sup>
    - i. Sessions provided an orientation to attendees on the language of the Guided Pathway Scale of Adoption Assessment within each area and develop basic goals and planning for Academic Year 20-21.
    - ii. Goal of sessions was to re-define priorities and also recruit new members into the Guided Pathways work.
    - iii. Sessions focused on 5 high priority areas of Guided Pathways: Program Maps, Starfish, Success Teams, Learning. & Engagement, Transitions
    - iv. Program Maps-Important to know how to use them. Will help to guide next iteration
    - v. Maintenance for maps-Information to be coming in from Colleague, there is a limited budget for Phase 3 on web re-design.
    - vi. Learning & Engagement spoke on Faculty Success’s and how to consider careers and life outside of the classroom as we align assignments and how students learn.
    - vii. Transitions focused on ways students are being prepared from HS to credit to non-credit programs, transfers to 4 years or particular workforce.
    - viii. Suggested to look into *Get Focused-Stay Focused* to be implemented along with Super-Strong. To help choose a pathway and solidify choice.

- x. Starfish: Original intent-early alert and implement it to the onboarding process
