#### Action Items:

- Ι. No Public Comments
  - a. Minutes were reviewed. Mary moved to approve and Susan seconded the motion. October 23 minutes were approved.
- 11. Reports
  - a. Student report
    - i. Upcoming Tech BBQ November 25. Emerging career tech careers.
    - ii. Kinesiology Awareness event November 26. Includes local companies demonstrating careers.
    - iii. Native American event tentatively next week.
  - b. Faculty
    - i. In an attempt to brand the 5<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month as the official Professional Development day, Glenn Doolittle presented "Help Your Students Find Their Career Pathway."
      - 1. Marketing needs improvement.
      - 2. Scheduling is a big factor for faculty.
    - ii. 10 faculty attended Skyline Equity Academy and will provide trainings at SAC.
    - iii. CEC PD Week
      - 1. 40 to 50 workshops & meetings expected to be scheduled for PD Week at CEC January 8-10, but it will be a light day on Friday the 10th.
      - 2. Keynote speaker Carmen Martinez del Calderon has been scheduled.
      - 3. Drs. Rose and Hubbard will also be speaking at the event.

## c. Classified

- i. Jimmy has helped the Classified Workgroup begin the Accessibility Training Course on canvas.
  - 1. Workshops planned at SCE include Accessibility, Title IX, Equity, AB 540 and a
  - customized workshops at SCE (ex: Communication skills workshop).
- d. Management
  - i. SACMA has organized a series of workshops to help train many of the new managers.
  - ii. The District has also created a manager workgroup because professional development has been lacking for Managers at the district.

#### III. Business

- a. Presented final proposed Shared Governance Structure.
  - i. There is currently a proposal for an update of the Shared Governance Structure that will include the Professional Development Advisory Committee and the workgroups. This change will be presented to College Council & Cabinet for approval by Dr. Lamb and Madeline Grant.
  - ii. View meeting materials to review the final proposed Participatory Governance Structure and the document outlining the Professional Development Committee.

- iii. Suggestion: Confirm that the org chart is the current org chart because the TLC committee is no longer a recognized SAC committee. Additionally, the Distance Ed committee could possibly be missing from the org chart.
- b. Professional Development Week Schedule presented.
  - i. The schedule will be available at <u>www.sac.edu/ProDevSchedule</u>.
  - ii. Convocation is expected to focus on the Skyline topics.
  - iii. The Student Basic Needs workshop/event will possibly be offered during the spring semester instead of PD week. The main organizers for this training (PD, Research, Student Life and ASG).
  - iv. Safe Space was addressed at the recent Distinguished Faculty Lecture. The speaker, Lance Lockwood, may be attending a training session at Long Beach, the week of February 3.
    - 1. Jose will also be invited to complete the training and both will be funded by Professional Development.
    - 2. Safe Space training needs to recommence at SAC. The training used to be done once a year at SAC. The webpage has been deleted or is currently unavailable.
  - v. Title IX speaker is desired instead of a workshop during PD week.
    - 1. Suggestion: The Violence 101 title is problematic.
  - vi. Convocation keynote speaker has not been scheduled.
    - 1. Dr. Pedro Noguera is not available.
    - 2. Suggestion: Miguel Powers, an interactive speaker who led an event at Fullerton College on the GrowthMindset topic.
- c. Accreditation Standards
  - i. Trainings will be offered during PD week, which will include an introduction and then breakout into 7 sessions.
  - ii. Suggestion: Strategic invitations to colleagues to assure a strong team for each Standard.
  - iii. ACCJC accredits the college every 6 years and will be reviewing the college structure and programs. They'll be interviewing students and employees. The Accreditation process requires considerable preparation.
    - 1. The college will be allowed to resolve any issues to maintain accreditation and not impact financial aid distribution.
    - 2. The ACCJC accreditation process has changed and is more supportive and less punitive.
- d. Microsoft Teams Introduction
  - i. Raquel has created a Professional Development Advisory Committee Teams page.
  - ii. It includes channels for all three workgroups and a general channel to store any working documents or encourage any workplace feedback for future projects.
  - iii. The Microsoft Teams app encourages seamless and effective collaboration among committees/workgroups.
  - iv. This software is slowly being employed across campus. Training will be provided next year in the spring to help improve familiarity.
