Empowering Students to Use AI Responsibly

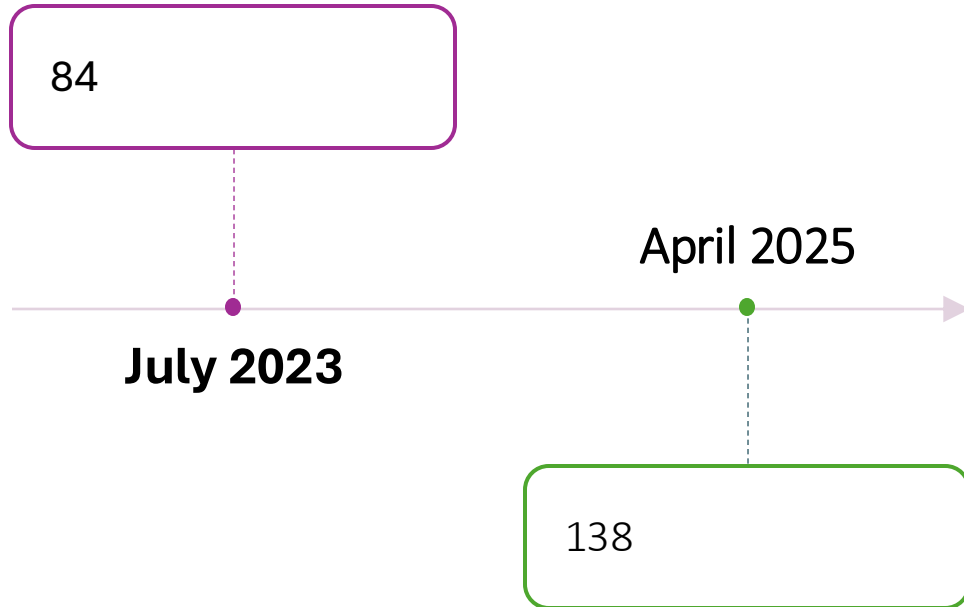
