## Instructions For Completing Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum Certification Petition Form

1. Request certification from the **last community college attended** prior to transfer.
2. For each area, circle courses taken at Santa Ana College, list courses taken at other colleges, or list name of exam if requirement was met through an Advanced Placement exam (minimum score of **3** is required). Advanced Placement **cannot be** used for Area 1 Group B (*Critical Thinking - English Composition*). Place check mark in **COMPLETED** column on right side.
3. Courses used for IGETC certification must be passed with a minimum grade of **C** (*C minus* is not acceptable, except for high school courses used to meet the UC Language other than English requirement). A *Credit* or *Pass* is acceptable providing either is equivalent to a grade of C or higher. A community college transcript or catalog must reflect this policy.
4. It is generally recommended that students complete all IGETC requirements prior to transfer. **By doing so students may obtain full certification.** Students may obtain **partial certification** however by completing all but one or two courses. (Completion of Areas 1 and 2 are usually necessary for UC transfer admission. In addition full certification is required to earn a Santa Ana College Certificate of Achievement, as well as an Associate Degree for Transfer. UC Berkeley's College of Letters and Science also requires full completion of IGETC as selection criteria for admission. Please see a counselor for additional information and advisement.)

Once you receive partial certification from Santa Ana College it is then your responsibility to consult with a counselor at your university to find out how to complete the IGETC. You do not need to reapply for full certification from SAC once you have completed the missing course(s).

5. On the bottom section of the form, check if IGETC certification is directed to the California State University, the University of California, or both. In addition, indicate whether you are requesting full or partial certification.
6. Although not part of IGETC, Santa Ana College may certify completion of the CSU graduation requirement in *U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals*. Circle the course(s) used to meet the requirement and place a check mark on the line next to **COMPLETED**.
7. Students earning an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) in Biology or Chemistry must complete **IGETC for STEM** as outlined below:

Complete the following courses before transfer:

- All courses in Areas 1 (except 1C for UC-bound students), 2, and 5; and
- One course in Area 3A; one course in Area 3B; and two courses in Area 4 from two different disciplines.

Complete the following courses after transfer:

- One remaining lower-division GE course in Area 3;\*
- One remaining lower-division GE course in Area 4;\* and
- One course in Area 6 for UC-bound students who have not satisfied it through proficiency.\*

\*These deferred lower division courses must be replaced with calculus and/or science courses required by the major before transfer.

IGETC for STEM completion does not qualify students for the IGETC Certificate of Achievement.
