## June 4, 2018 – July 17, 2018 TESTING SCHEDULE

All students **must** have a picture I.D. to test. **Appointments are required for TELD and paper and pencil CTEP & Math tests appointments can be made online at [www.sac.edu/studentservices/testingcenter](http://www.sac.edu/studentservices/testingcenter).** CTEP (English and reading), MDTP (math) and TELD (ESL) computer based testing is available on a walk-in basis. Please arrive 30 minutes early to check in for CTEP and TELD tests and 20 minutes early for Math test. All students will need to schedule an appointment for orientation and advisement after testing in order to receive tests results.

**MATH:** The Math Diagnostic Testing Project (MDTP) has four different levels. Choose the level you feel you are best prepared to take. Sample questions are available for each test.  
**Math test scores are only valid for one year.** If you took the math test more than one year prior to the date you register and you did not take a math class during that year, you will need to retest.

**CTEP:** For native speakers of English or others who have studied English and/or ESL in school for at least seven years or who use English frequently on a daily basis.  
**Test scores are only valid for two years.** If you took the English placement test more than two years prior to the date you register and you did not take an English class during those years, you will need to retest.

**TELD:** For students whose native language is not English and who have not studied English and/or ESL in school for at least seven years or who do not use English frequently on a daily basis.  
**Test scores are only valid for two years.** If you took the ESL placement test more than two years prior to the date you register and you did not take an ESL class during those years, you will need to retest.

**STUDENT SUCCESS AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS** – In an effort to promote student success, placement testing, orientation and development of an educational plan are core services required of all entering students as mandated by the Student Success and Support Program, 3SP, (effective Fall 2014). Not completing these core services may result in the loss of priority registration. To begin to complete the 3SP core requirements, go to the Testing Center Homepage at <http://sac.edu/StudentServices/AssessmentCenter/Pages/default.aspx> and schedule an appointment for placement testing, student I.D. number is required to schedule appointments. If you are a **new student at SAC** you need to:

1. submit an application
2. receive your web advisor log in (via email)
3. receive your student I.D. number (you can locate your number in your web advisor by going to the student menu page, look under “User Account” and click on “What’s My Student Number/Staff ID Number”)

After you complete placement testing, you will receive an appointment for orientation and advisement. During orientation and advisement a counselor will inform you of the many services available to help you achieve success in college. The counselor will also assist you in developing an abbreviated educational plan.

If you completed placement testing at another college, please bring your placement test results to the Counseling Center to determine if you are exempt from assessment and may be referred to alternate core services. Under certain conditions students may be exempt from the 3SP requirements. To see if you are exempt, go to the Counseling Division Homepage on the SAC Website and look under Student Success and Support Services Program (3SP).
