# **Basic Skills Competency Requirement**

### What is it?

 This is a requirement that must be met before the California teaching credential or certificate will be issued. To fulfill this requirement, applicants must demonstrate basic skills proficiency in reading, writing, and math.

#### Who needs it?

• The requirement needs to be met by those who want to apply for a credential or certificate to serve in the public schools of California. This requirement may also be required as a condition of employment to work at a school district.

#### How do I meet this requirement? Complete **ONE** of the following options: Pass the CSET: **Demonstrate Pass the CBEST** Pass a Basic Skills **Multiple Subjects** proficiency on CSU **Exam from another** AND **Early Assessment** Tests reading, math, state the CSET: Writing Program (EAP) and writing skills **Skills Exam** Only needs to be passed once Offered computer or Achieve acceptable paper-based **Demonstrate** Achieve acceptable scores on selected Must earn total score proficiency on CSU **SAT or ACT Scores for** of 123 or above **College Board Placement Exams English and Math Advanced Placement** (EPT and ELM) (AP) Exams
