

The Chapman University (CU) C-TAG agreement is a transfer admissions guarantee with Santa Ana College (SAC) for students in teacher education pathway majors who are seeking to major in Integrated Educational Studies (IES) once at CU. Students pursuing this major for either Elementary Education or Special Education have the option of one of the following minors that are part of the IES program:

- Integrated Educational Studies major with a Disability Studies minor
- Integrated Educational Studies major with a Language and Literacy minor

The C-TAG agreement is for interested transfer students entering CU beginning in the fall 2021 semester. Students must meet all requirements listed below to be eligible for C-TAG.

Please read and initial each item below as acknowledgement of the eligibility requirements:

- _____ Meet with a Center for Teacher Education (CFTE) counselor to review requirements, develop an education plan, and submit/sign the C-TAG for Future Educators Agreement.
- _____ Once the C-TAG for Future Educators Agreement is signed by the student, a CFTE counselor will share contact information with CU so that they can begin to work with the student on scheduling a one-on-one CU educational and financial aid advising appointment.
- _____ Complete the pre-admission coursework outlined below. Any of these transfer preparation options can be in progress when applying and just need to be completed by the time the student starts their CU courses.

General Education (GE) Requirements: Students who have completed any of the following will have met minimum eligibility for transfer and will have satisfied the majority of the GE requirements for CU –

- California State University General Education Breadth (CSU-GE Breadth) certification **OR**
- Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) certification **OR**
- Completion of an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

IES Major/Minor Articulated Course Requirements: The following CU major preparation courses are required to be completed at SAC and/or SCC for direct admission into the Integrated Educational Studies major with the specified minor. All required major courses must have a minimum grade of a C or higher.

Note that CU has both a spring and fall application cycle for transfer students. **Students must apply for admission by either priority postmark deadline to be considered for the C-TAG.**

Spring	October 15	Classes taken through the end of the fall semester will be considered.
