

Chapman Transfer Agreement Guarantee (C-TAG)

Contract for Santa Ana College Students

“Chapman C-TAG” offers a transfer agreement guarantee with Santa Ana College (SAC) students in the teacher education pathway who are seeking to transfer to Chapman University, beginning with the Spring 2025 semester. C-TAG specifically sets forth admission requirements for SAC students pursuing a *Liberal Studies major with an Elementary Education minor* at Chapman University. Students must meet all requirements listed below to be eligible for C-TAG.

Please read and initial each item below as acknowledgement of the eligibility requirements:

- _____ Meet with a Center for Teacher Education (CFTE) counselor to review requirements, develop an education plan, and submit/sign this C-TAG Contract.
- _____ Once the C-TAG Contract is signed by the student, a CFTE counselor will share contact information with Chapman University so that they can begin to work with the student on scheduling a one-on-one advising appointment with a Chapman University Admissions Advisor to discuss application process and financial aid.
- _____ Complete the pre-admission coursework outlined below. Any of these transfer preparation options can be in progress when applying, but need to be completed by the time the student starts their Chapman University courses.

General Education (GE) Requirements: Students who have completed any of the following will have met minimum eligibility for transfer and will have satisfied the majority of the GE requirements for Chapman University –

- California State University General Education Breadth (CSU-GE Breadth) certification **OR**
- Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) certification **OR**
- Completion of an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

Liberal Studies Major with Elementary Education Minor Articulated Course

Requirements: The following Chapman University major preparation courses are required to be completed at SAC and/or SCC for direct admission into the Liberal Studies major with the Elementary Education minor. All required courses must have a minimum grade of C or higher.

_____ Apply for admission through the Chapman University application process at www.chapman.edu/apply including meeting all other admission requirements and deadlines as outlined by Chapman University (application fee will be waived). Note that Chapman University has both a Fall and Spring application cycle for transfer students. **Students must apply for admission by either priority deadline to be considered for the C-TAG.**

Term	Application Deadline	Note
Fall	February 15	Classes taken through the end of the summer semester will be considered.
Spring	October 15	Classes taken through the end of the fall semester will be considered.

_____ Submit a financial aid application by March 2. Be sure to add “Chapman University” in the “School Selection” section.
