- How many mentees per mentor? There will be two mentees assigned per mentor.
- How long is my commitment to the program? One full academic year; Fall to Spring semesters.
- Is there a fee to participate? No, the application and program are free to all SAC students.
- When can I participate the program? Mentees may participate one year prior to Fall transfer.
- How will I be paired with a mentor? Mentor and mentee pairing is based on major, school of attendance, transfer institution of choice, and mentor/mentee availability.
