

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SB 1914* CROSS ENROLLMENT

California Community Colleges - California State University
**Sections 66755 & 66756 of SB 1914 have been amended by SB 361*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Any student enrolled in any campus of the California Community Colleges, the California State University, or the University of California may enroll without formal admission in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either of the other systems on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities on both campuses. Enrollment is excluded in the following areas: Remedial, Summer Session, Graduate (Including Teacher Education courses at the 200 and 300 level).

A student is qualified to cross-enroll if the student has met all of the following requirements:

- completed at least one term at the home campus as a matriculated student
- enrolled for a minimum of six units for the current term
- earned a grade point average of 2.000 (grade of C) for work completed at home campus
- paid appropriate tuition and fees at home campus for the current term
- completed appropriate academic preparation as determined by host campus
- California residency based on the guidelines set forth by the home campus

ENROLLMENT CONDITIONS: PRIOR TO ENROLLMENT, STUDENT MUST SECURE APPROVAL OF HOME CAMPUS COLLEGE/SCHOOL FOR CROSS ENROLLMENT TO ENSURE COURSE MEETS HOME CAMPUS REQUIREMENTS.

1. Approval for cross-enrollment is valid **only for the one term specified** and subject to space availability, deadlines, registration procedures and priorities at UCI.
2. The cost to enroll is \$20 per unit and \$10 computer account fee.
3. Additional fees required of other students (lab, materials, breakage, computer, transcript, etc.) will be assessed.
4. Academic advisement is available only at the home campus.
5. Students are urged to secure approval of home campus advisor to ensure course meets home campus requirements.
6. Evidence of completion of course prerequisites (e.g., an official transcript) may be required at the time of enrollment by the instructor/academic counselor.
7. Financial aid is available only through home campus. Students eligible for Veterans, Rehabilitation, Social Security, and other Federal, State, or County benefits must secure eligibility certification through home campus.
8. Permanent academic records are maintained at the Student Services Office at University Extension. Official transcript - \$10 per copy.
9. Health Services on host campus are limited to treatment for emergencies.
10. Because of overlapping academic calendars, cross enrollment is possible only in certain combinations.

11. Participation in student activities or use of the student union at the host campus is subject to any limitation set by UCI.
12. Parking at UCI is subject to fees and space availability. For more information please contact Parking and Transportation at (949) 824-7486.
13. Information concerning UCI identification card policies will be provided at registration.
14. Students are subject to all UCI administrative procedures. Note: Students must process official drop at UCI or risk having an unsatisfactory grade recorded on permanent record.

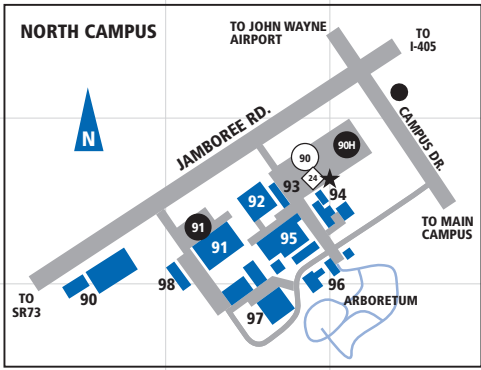
