

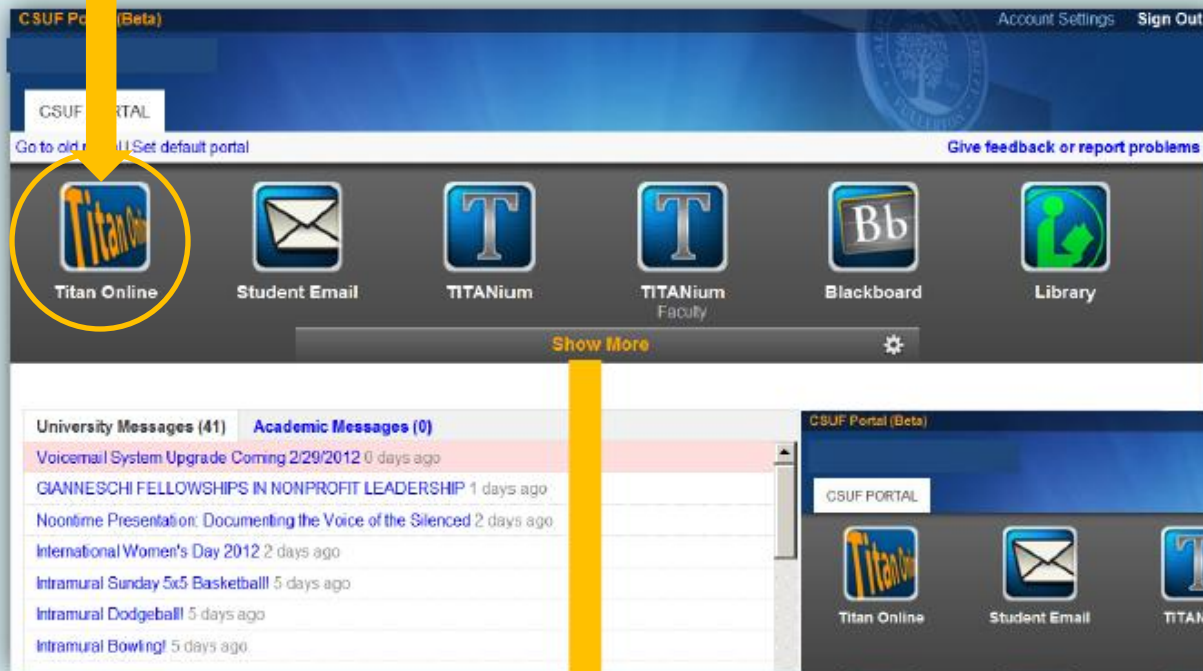
Using Your Student Portal

CSU Approves Fall 2012 Fee Increases

The CSU makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in the published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees, without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as **estimates** that are subject to change upon approval by The Board of Trustees.

On November 15-16, 2011, the California State University Board of Trustees voted to increase tuition fees effective Fall 2012 by 9%.
