## INSTRUCTIONS ON GETTING IRS VERIFICATION OF NON-FILING LETTER

## Obtain IRS Form 4506-T from the Financial Aid Office or download at https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506t.pdf

- Complete lines 1 − 4, following the instructions on page 2 of theform.
- Line 3: enter the non-filer's street address and zip or postal code. Use the address currently onfile with the IRS. (If any)
- Line 5 provides non-filers with the option to have their IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter mailed directly to a third party by the IRS. Do not have your IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter sent directly to Santa AnaCollege.
- Line 7: Select the checkbox on the right-hand side for Verification of Non-filing.
- Line 9: Year or period requested field, enter "12/31/2020". Mail the completed IRS Form 4506-T to:
