- A student who did not file taxes in 2022 must submit a copy of the 2022 W-2 statement to the Financial Aid Office for each source of employment income in 2021. Student must also complete this signed form showing the sources and amounts of the student's **income earned from work**. If the student was not provided a W-2, he/she must explain why not. If the student has no income from work, put "None" under Source of Income from Work and "\$0" under Total amount for 2022.
- If you lost your W-2(s), you must either obtain a new copy from your employer *or* get a Wage Transcript from the IRS
- You must also certify that you have not filed, and are not required to file, a 2022 tax return. If you have filed or are required to file a 2022 tax return you must correct and resubmit your FAFSA instead of completing this form.

Net Self-Employment Income includes any income for which you worked and did not receive a W-2. This includes baby-sitting, house-cleaning, or any "under the table" work. If the Net Self-Employment Income for 2022 equals \$400 or more, you must file federal income taxes for 2022 before we can process your financial aid application.

To calculate Net Self-Employment Income: Subtract any business expenses from the total income received during 2022. You may download the IRS Schedule C-EZ worksheet to help you calculate your Net Self-Employment Income at: http://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f1040sce.pdf
