Financial Aid Termination Due to Students Failed Probationary Status

An evaluation of students' satisfactory academic progress has been performed at the end of **Spring 2021** semester. You did not successfully meet the conditions of your probationary status. **As a result, our records indicate that you have been disqualified from all financial aid programs starting Summer 2021 semester due to your unsatisfactory academic progress.**

- Although you have been disqualified from financial aid, you do remain eligible to attend Santa Ana College.
- You may receive 2021-2022 California College Promise Grant (CCPG) (formerly known as the BOG Fee Waiver) to waive your Summer 2021, Fall 2021, and Spring 2022 enrollment fees. *If you meet the qualification and the standard academic progress for this program which will be evaluated at the end of each semester.*

You may regain eligibility for financial aid in future terms if you raise your GPA to 2.0 or higher and raise your course completion percentage to 66.5% or higher. Here are recommendations to help you regain financial aid eligibility:

- Meet with a counselor for academic advisement regarding the type of classes you need to be enrolled in to fulfill your educational goal.
- Visit the Learning Center for tutoring services.
- Take only the number of classes you can successfully complete with at least a "C" grade.
- You may need to retake classes in which you received an "F" or "D" grade. Once you retake a class, complete a request form to Admissions & Records Office for the new grade be entered on your transcript. A higher grade in those classes will help raise your cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA). Discuss the possibility of Academic Renewal with your academic counselor.

The Financial Aid Office will not accept an appeal for your next term unless there is a documented medical issue that caused the "W", "D", and/or "F" grade(s) in your prior term. A future appeal may be submitted after you have completed six or more units from your educational plan with a "C" grade or higher with no "W", "D", or "F" grades.
