

Potential Activities and Outcomes (From draft Logic Model)

ASK

- **All students have a comprehensive educational plan and are placed into a Career & Academic Pathway (CAP)**
→ **Outcome:** 95% of new students have a comprehensive ed plan and are assigned to a CAP within their first term.
 - **Student Success Team touchpoint campaign to contact every student at least 2x per semester**
→ **Outcome:** 80%+ of students respond to at least one success team outreach per semester, with an increase in persistence rates from term to term.
 - **Encourage full-time enrollment**
→ **Outcome:** Increase first-time, full-time enrollment rate by 10 percentage points, leading to higher persistence and degree/certificate completion within three years.
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CONNECT

- **Operationalize CAPs, connecting students to faculty, alumni, and employers**
→ **Outcome:** 75% of students participate in at least one networking opportunity with faculty, alumni, or employers within their first year.
 - **Implement a monthly-themed events**
→ **Outcome:** Student participation in engagement events increases by 30%, correlating with higher retention.
 - **Increase internships**
→ **Outcome:** Internship participation doubles, with 70%+ of participants reporting increased confidence in career readiness.
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INSPIRE

- **Center for Teaching & Learning professional development (PD)**
→ **Outcome:** 70%+ of faculty engage in PD annually, leading to measurable improvements in student-centered instruction and course success rates.
 - **Implement learning communities**
→ **Outcome:** Students in paired courses demonstrate higher persistence rates (by at least 10%) compared to non-participants.
 - **Contextualized student success course per CAP**
→ **Outcome:** Students completing the course demonstrate higher completion of 9+ college-level credits in their first term and higher persistence rates.
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PLAN

- **Comprehensive Ed Plan update check-ins**
→ **Outcome:** 80%+ of students update their ed plan at least once per year, improving on-time completion rates.
- **Increase Pell recipients**
→ **Outcome:** Pell application and receipt rates increase by 15%, improving affordability and retention for low-income students.
- **Student-centered schedule**
→ **Outcome:** 70%+ of students can access a full course load (morning, evening, hybrid, or online) aligned with their needs, leading to higher completion rates.
- **Increase English & Math completion in the 1st year**
→ **Outcome:** The percentage of students completing transfer-level English & Math in their first year increases by 20 percentage points, a key milestone for completion.
- **Every student has a program map**
→ **Outcome:** 100% of programs have clear program maps, and students in mapped pathways complete degrees at higher rates.
