 - i. ITS updated the <u>aging report</u> presented last time to include the 5th year of the current cycle (fiscal year '26-'27).
 - ii. The 518 computers that have been deployed so far this year does not include the 817 that were purchased this fiscal year. (They were from other sources like the new Johnson Center Building.) Out of the 817 purchased, 179 laptops have been received and 89 desktops have been received.
