4. Read of Draft 2025-2029 District Strategic Technology Plan [information] (20 mins.)

John Steffens discussed the SIX THEMES from the Tech Plan. The STP aligns with institutional goals, accreditation standards (ACCJC), and district plans to support student success and operational efficiency. It is a flexible, living document adaptable to evolving technological trends.

The plan addresses challenges in higher education, emphasizing:

- Adoption of emerging technologies (AI, VR, AR) to enhance learning (aligned with Vision 2030).
- Cybersecurity to protect data and systems.
- Faculty development for hybrid learning and technology use.
- Internal goals: barrier removal, efficiency, data-driven systems, and user-friendly tools.

Six Strategic Themes

- 1. Student Success and Support
- 2. Digital Transformation and Innovation
- 3. Equity and Inclusion



- 4. Data-Driven Decision Making
- 5. Cybersecurity and Privacy
- 6. Standardization and Resilience

Each theme includes actionable initiatives to improve teaching, operations, equity, and future readiness.

An environmental analysis (internal/external) informed themes, leveraging insights from **EDUCAUSE** reports (e.g., 2025 Top 10 IT Issues, 2024 Horizon Report) to identify trends and priorities in higher education technology.

The STP is a dynamic roadmap for leveraging technology to achieve institutional missions while adapting to rapid technological and educational changes.
