IV. DISTANCE EDUCATION UPDATE

C. Kushida requested that to improve DE Addendum approvals and to reduce delays, division curriculum committees should review their courses prior to CIC submission. She further recommended that a thorough review of the Addendum be completed by an assigned division faculty member with online experience or knowledge of the DE Addendum. In particular, regular effective contact with students and between students should assure that contact is regular, required and hopefully assessed. She stressed that faculty not forget to look at and ensure checkmarks are made in appropriate checkboxes.

V. PROGRAM DEGREES/CERTIFICATE REVISIONS, REGULATIONS

B. Sos reported the challenges in technology, catalog production and Chancellor's Office Curriculum Inventory (COCI) the Curriculum Office is currently facing as it relates to programs.

B. Sos reiterated that Career Education (CE) programs are required to undergo a program review cycle every two (2) years. He stressed the importance of obtaining Board of Trustees' approval date on CE programs as it is crucial for submission in COCI. CE 2-year program review documents may be obtained from K. Matthews in the CE Office. He also stressed the importance of faculty roles as originators, department chairs, division chairs and CIC representatives to complete regular degree and certificate modifications when courses change.

R. Vazquez shared three (3) programs as examples of the challenges brought forth by B. Sos.

R. Manson, Financial Aid, stressed the importance of keeping programs up-to-date. He stated that every certificate of achievement needs to be approved by Federal Financial Aid.

R. Manson mentioned that with the new funding formula and Guided Pathways, approval of these programs by the Department of Education is crucial. The Department of Education reviews programs in our catalog and COCI to ensure that CIP codes, titles and minimum units match the information found in Colleague.

B. Sos asked CIC representatives to inform their constituents that program's unit values need to be reviewed and corrected as well as Program Learning Outcomes (PLOs). He will make a video with the steps needed to fulfill these tasks only. They will be considered non-substantial changes. He stressed the importance of completing this clean-up by April 22, 2020. <https://www.sac.edu/committees/curriculum/Pages/METAuserguide.aspx>

Discussion followed.

VI. READING PROFICIENCY – FIRST READ

The Reading Proficiency proposal was reviewed for first read. Discussion ensued. Counseling Department requested that the Reading Proficiency proposal, once approved as presented, be retroactive to 2019-2020.

VII.a. Accreditation Report

F. Ortiz reported that a team has been formed for each standard. The teams have begun to meet and gather evidence. He stated that the deadline to submit evidence has been extended to May 8th due to the current situation we are facing. He further mentioned that the Accreditation Steering Committee will be meeting Wednesday. No communication from ACCJC has been received changing our accreditation visit.

VII.b. Articulation Report

P. Canzona stated that CSU/UC acceptance of courses is a non-issue to students regardless of the mode of instruction. She cautioned faculty about Pass/No Pass courses and how these will be accepted by UC/CSU. She further advised faculty to be careful with transfer courses.

S. Bautista explained that Excused Withdrawal (EW)/Pass-No Pass/Incomplete option links are currently found in the Admissions and Records home page. He further mentioned that communication from the Santa Ana College (SAC) President and the SAC Public Information Officer on how to choose the various options/policies is being sent to students. This communication contains links to webpages on how to use and submit these to Admissions and Records.

C. Truong mentioned that the Admissions and Records website has been updated to include a link for grades and transcripts.

Discussion ensued with faculty sharing general concern of EW requests as an easy alternative to drop a class.
