Grade Alleviation for pre-transfer level Coursework:

A student who earns a substandard grade (“D”, “F” or NP) in pre-transfer level English or math course(s) shall have the option of grade alleviation by earning a “C” or better or P in a transfer-level English (CSU GE area A2 or IGETC GE area 1A approved course,) or math (CSU GE area B4 or IGETC GE 2A approved course). No more than two substandard grades for the same course may be alleviated and excluded from G.P.A. (as per Title 5 section 55042 and 55046).

Grade Alleviation for pre-transfer level Coursework:
